

Silent Order of Aeromodeling by Radio
FIELD EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE
INCENTIVE PROGRAM
(Enacted June 19, 2009)

ARTICLE I
PURPOSE AND ELIGIBILITY

Section 1.01: Purpose

The Silent Order of Aeromodeling by Radio (S.O.A.R.) recognizes it does not own any model sailplane winches and relies upon its members to share their personal winches. The club wishes to help defray the cost of maintaining its members' winches and related field equipment when that gear is regularly provided for club activity, including general use and contests.

Section 1.02: Eligibility

The Field Equipment Maintenance Incentive Program is open to all S.O.A.R. members in good standing who own winches and associated field equipment that is regularly used for club activity.

ARTICLE II
PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Section 2.01: Participation Requirements

All of the following requirements must be met:

- The field equipment must be regularly used for club activity and recognized as such by a majority of members present during the club meeting when application is made.
- Application for benefits must be made in person by the equipment owner at a club meeting.
- The applicant must describe the parts purchased and present a receipt for their purchase.

Section 2.02: Limitations

The program is limited to replacement parts purchased for the maintenance of field equipment already owned by a member. This program does not include the replacement of winch line.

ARTICLE III
PROGRAM BENEFITS

Section 3.01: Maximum Benefit

S.O.A.R. will reimburse fifty percent of the cost of qualifying replacement parts up to a maximum of \$50.00 per member per calendar year.
